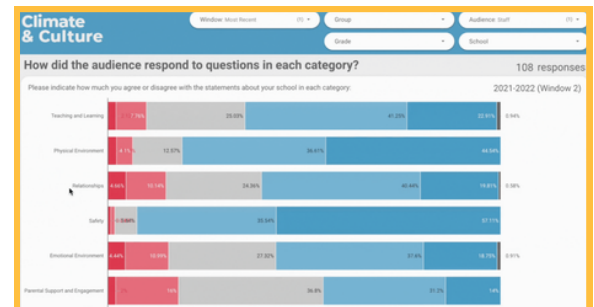


Five Star School & District Surveys

CLIMATE & CULTURE



Better understand your school's climate & culture from the viewpoints of multiple stakeholders: **teacher/staff**, **parent/guardian**, **elementary students**, and **secondary students**.



Survey results are displayed on the dashboard in the following categories: **Teaching & Learning**, **Relationships**, **Physical Environment**, **Safety**, **Emotional Environment**, **Morale in School**, **Parental Support & Engagement**, and **Administration Support**.

By viewing data in the Climate & Culture Survey Dashboard, you can identify changes in opinions from each survey cycle, compare results among buildings and audiences, and identify areas in need of the most attention.

Elementary Students could respond to each question using a 3-point scale: No, Sometimes, Yes. Elementary/Secondary Students, Parents, and Staff could respond to each question using a 5-point scale: Strongly Disagree to Strongly Agree.

The sample set below comes from the Climate & Culture Teacher/Staff Survey

- Students at this school are encouraged to think critically.
- The school's schedule allows adequate time for teacher preparation and planning
- I take pride in the appearance of the school
- At this school, teachers are treated and respected as educational professionals
- Class sizes are appropriate
- I am proud to tell others I work at this school
- School administrators give me useful feedback on my job.
- I am satisfied with opportunities for my professional growth.
- Teachers talk with students about ways to understand and control emotions
- I feel safe in the classroom
- Students in this school respect each other's differences (i.e., gender, race, culture, etc.)
- Parents know what is going on in this school
- Parents are aware of what is expected of their child at this school
- School administrators give me useful feedback on my job.
